

NON-RESIDENT ARRIVAL DATA




ARRIVAL MODES




Room Demand




MONTANA ARRIVAL DATA

- Glacier National Park East Entrance Closed
- Canadian Border Closed
- Major City Pass Through
- Annual Operating Revenue from previous year collections
- Flying Comfort
- Lodging Comfort
- NEW MultiPurpose Event Center Future
- County Health Variances
- 20% CVB/Region Administration Cap



SURVIVE 2021 – 2022 CHALLENGED

- \$206,222 Tourism Safety Grant
- \$36,164 Relief Funds
- Not Eligible for Paycheck Protection Program
- Applying for EDA Funds
- Unable to secure CDBG Funds
- No 2020 State Tourism Grant Cycle
- 2021 Budget Planned -39% over 2020, at +3% Today
- Estimated 2022 Budget -45% over 2021
